CABO RICO'S NORTHEAST 400

The Northeast 400 is a modern American motorsailer. Handsome motorsailers have been designed and built in the past, but they neither sailed nor powered well. The 42 ft. NE 400 is well balanced in her performance providing upwind speeds of 7 knots under sail. Her 100 hp, Yanmar Diesel engine, allows for powered cruising at 7.5-8 knots in rough weather conditions.

Cabo Rico's secret for these great dual speeds is found in their creative hull designs. The NE 400 is naturally fine forward and long on the water. Compromise is not in designer Mark Ellis' vocabulary. Special features, like the inside steering station and remarkable stowage space, sets the NE 400 apart. It is a boat designed to endear its captain and crew regardless of weather conditions.

Craftsmanship abounds in this beauty, built in Cabo Rico's San Jose, Costa Rico boatyard. Quality begins with a MarsKeel Technology keel and finished by craftsman that have an average of 17 years experience with Cabo Rico. This resource of talent allows buyers to choose their own specifications and design criteria, while maintaining high quality standards. The design, incorporates 8.5 feet overhead in the airy and open galley. The spacious den, coupled with the extensive fuel and water tank capacities, make her a long range boat, that is responsive, safe and extremely comfortable.
